Illness Report Form Information

How it works:

Should your child become sick with a fever, experience vomiting, diarrhea, or contract a communicable disease such as lice, chicken pox, or pink eye, they will be sent home. The Illness Report form will state their condition and when they may return. With Chicken Pox, they may return to preschool when the pox are scabbed over. If a child is sent home with head lice, they will need to check in to the school office prior to going to their classroom. They will be checked for nits. Children that are not healthy will not be admitted to preschool.

Thank you for your cooperation in our ongoing effort to keep your children and our staff healthy.
